

# 2023 Prep Enrolment

Plenty Parklands PS operates according to The Department of Education and Training guidelines. All Melbourne schools have a local neighbourhood area. All children who are eligible to attend a Victorian Government school are welcome to attend PPPS if we are their closest school.

Plenty Parklands also has an Enrolment Ceiling. When there are insufficient places at our school for all students who seek entry, students are enrolled in the following priority order:

- Students for whom the school is the designated neighbourhood school.
- Students with a sibling at the same permanent address who are attending the school at the same time.
- Other students will be placed on a waiting list and will be offered an enrolment if places are available. Enrolments will only be accepted for the next calendar year.

Students enrolling at our school as part of a prep intake are required to provide original or certified copies of:

- Proof of age (indicating that they have turned 5 years of age by the 30th April 2023).
- An Immunisation History Statement from the Australian Immunisation Register.
- Proof of residence. (e.g. any 2 of the following - Drivers Licence, 12 month Lease Agreement/Council Rates notice, utility bills - gas, electricity).
